A platform of 1000 additional places (instead of 700) with an annual budget of 3.5M € which will be doubled, in response to the increase in places, to more easily access these same targets of young students in the entrance exams has five large French administrative schools: ENA, INET, EHESP, ENSP and ENAP. A 1000-PLACE « PREPA TALENT » PLATFORM FOR UNDERPRIVILEGED STUDENTS

The biggest announcement of this President Macron campaign aimed at "young people in France" consists concretely in the addition of 1,000 additional places which will be created at the start of the 2021 school year in the CPI, and renamed "Prépas Talents" (bearing the total number of students to 1,700 instead of 700 previously), and the diversity allowances will be doubled, from 2,000 to 4,000 euros. These Talent Preparations, intended for the most deserving scholarship students in higher education, will be present throughout the country, integrated either into public service schools or universities.

A call for expressions of interest is now launched for establishments applying to host these classes. From April, the list of new Public Service Talent Prep will be published by the Ministry of Transformation and Public Service. The government's objective is "that each region has at least two Talent Preparations", with the objective "to be as close as possible to families, to where we live", explained the Head of State, Emmanuel Macron. He was also able to realize by discussing with his students, the IRA that everyone learned "by chance" while surfing the net, the existence of these "prepa talents". It therefore still resists a concern for communication with young students who are directly concerned. Hence the question is doubled when it comes to young students with disabilities, whose access to information to access the functions of excellence, such as that of large administrative schools, does not seem to be theirs. communicated.

These preparatory classes for public service schools, intended for pupils of modest origins, will welcome 1,700 pupils at the start of the next school year, against 700 at present; they will be deployed throughout the territory, "according to a territorial grid which will include at least two preparations per region", specifies Emmanuel Macron, during his visit to the Nantes IRA on February 11, 2021.
